  - vi. Still high attendance at Residential Boards (~50, sometimes 55).

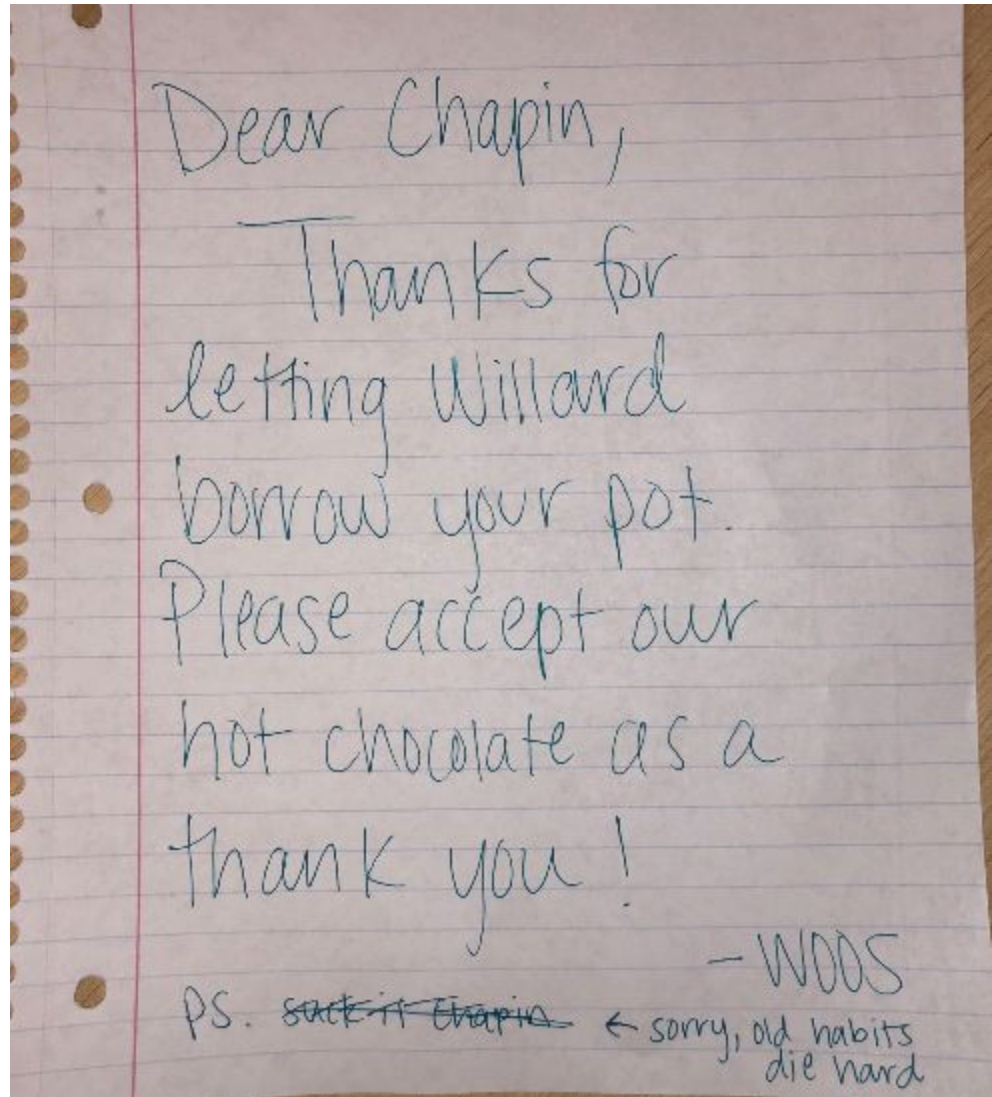
