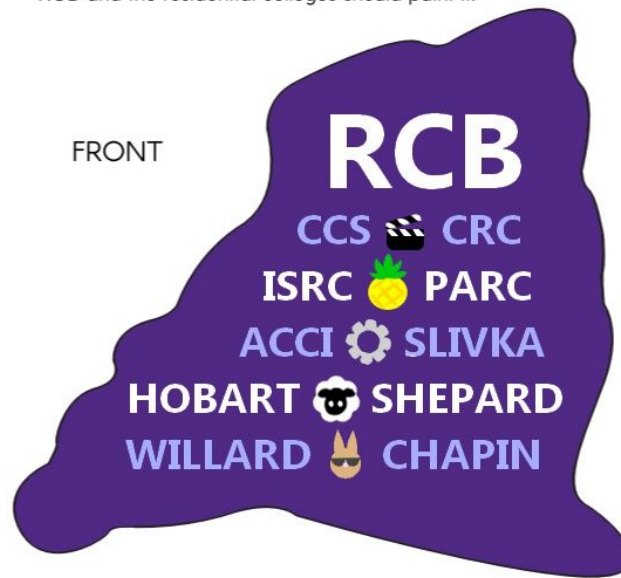

Color the rock with your own creative design of how you think RCB and the residential colleges should paint it!

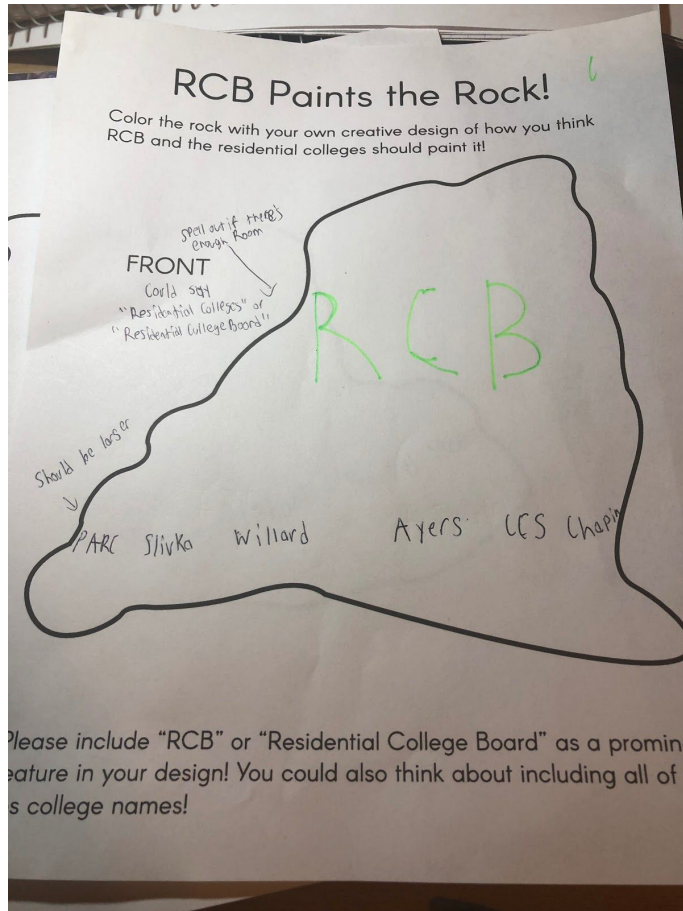
